# 1:1 Personal Laptop Program – Year 10 2016

## The Parent Funded Program

The College has chosen to move towards the Laptop/Tablet PC platform throughout the school as this innovative, new form of ICT is particularly well suited to learning environments. The device chosen for 2016 is the:

**Lenovo Yoga 11e Convertible Notebook.** This device was chosen because:

- It is compact and easy to transport
- It has a long battery life, whereby it can be used all day without charging
- It provides students with a common tool that meets their technological learning needs
- The level of interactivity and diverse modes of use, will support innovative learning opportunities which are not possible with other forms of ICT

## Warranty

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The laptop will be the student's to keep and use at school and home. Students are responsible for the care of the laptop.

All laptops have a unique serial number which will be recorded against individual student names for the purposes of identification, warranty and repair.

Distribution of Laptops will occur during an information / workshop session on the evening of **Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> January 2016**. A parent/guardian and child are required to attend these sessions as per the agreement. Further details regarding this session will be distributed in due course.
