**COVID-19 Update – Activation of Year 10 Independent Remote Learning**

As we approach the conclusion of Term Two 2022, the College is experiencing an increasing number of our staff needing to isolate due to contracting COVID-19 or other illness. To date we have been able to employ supply teachers to cover the classes of absent teachers, however this is proving to be increasingly difficult as the current COVID-19 context continues to evolve.

As such, the College will be activating Independent Remote Learning for Year 10 students on **Thursday 23 June 2022**.

This strategy aims to provide students with the opportunity to experience continuity in learning and continue with key elements of their programs whilst enabling the College to continue to operate.

In circumstances where students are scheduled to engage in Independent Remote Learning, they will be required to learn from home or an offsite location for the day and log into MyPenola to complete the coursework provided by subject teachers. Students will be required to allocate time to tasks as per their College Timetable for the nominated day. Please note the day will begin with Period One and no homegroup will be required.

The College is able to make exceptions for vulnerable children in Year 10 who are unable to engage in Independent Remote Learning on Thursday 23 June 2022. We therefore anticipate a small number of Year 10 students who may need onsite supervision at Penola Catholic College. Importantly, those students who must attend school will not be receiving direct instruction, rather they will be supervised by a small number of teachers and will be engaged in the same independent coursework as the students learning offsite.

If you believe your family is unable to facilitate Independent Remote Learning for your Year 10 child on Thursday 23 June 2022 for specific reasons, please use the link provided (<https://forms.office.com/r/iS52Y5i9fr>) to register your child by **6.30pm on Wednesday 22 June 2022** to enable us to plan appropriate supervision and support. A member of staff will contact each family seeking supervision to discuss your specific needs.

Classes and/or previously planned alternative programs will continue to operate for all other year levels as planned on this day.

We thank you for your continued support as we navigate these uncertain times.
