All Year 11 students who have Exams will be expected to be present for their Exams in winter or summer uniform (no PE uniform) as per the schedule on the Year 11 page and VCE page on MyPenola. Students are to please arrive 20 minutes prior to the Exam beginning in order to line up outside their exam location.

Students are required to bring their ID Card and their writing materials (pens, pencils, eraser etc). If they bring a water bottle into the Exam room, it must be in a clear bottle. Students are only required at school for their scheduled Exam and are permitted to leave the College at the conclusion of their last scheduled Exam for the day. Any students who wish to stay onsite to study are most welcome to do so either in the ERC or other designated space as directed by the Year Level Coordinator. Students who cannot attend school due to illness etc must notify a Year Level Coordinator with a medical certificate.

The Headstart program from Wednesday 27 November to Wednesday 4 December is compulsory and essential preparation for the 2025 school year.

A variety of excursions and on-site activities will be taking place for VCE VM students during the exam and Headstart period. Families are advised to please see operoo for specific information about each excursion.
