Dear Families,

We are fast approaching the end of the school year, with Year 9's being involved in a number of learning experiences during this time. Subject teachers are working with their students to finalise course requirements and students are to continue working diligently to complete any outstanding tasks. Please be reminded that attendance for all students is important and will support students as they finalise their assessment tasks and prepare for end of year exams.

Important school dates for students and parents to know

- Year 9 examinations run from Monday, 20 November Friday, 24 November (timetable on final page).
- A Student Free Day will occur on Monday, 27 November for all students.
- An exam feedback day will take place on Tuesday, 28 November for all year 9 students.
- The Headstart program commences Wednesday, 29 November until Wednesday, 6 December, where students will begin Year 10 classes.
- Term 4 concludes on Wednesday, 6 December at 3pm.

Homeroom will take place each morning, with the exception of Friday, 24 November (see timetable on final page for further clarification). All students must attend their assigned examinations and medical certificates are required if a student is ill. This is a learning experience to support and prepare students for the requirements of their senior schooling and, regardless of the students' pathways in Year 10 and beyond, assessment under test conditions is a component of vocational or mainstream courses that needs to be practised starting from this examination period.

Please note on the examination timetable the afternoons that your child may be permitted to leave the College early if they do not have a scheduled examination, any class work to follow up or scheduled detention consequences. On Friday, 24 November some students will not be required at school until recess. Students are, however, welcome to remain on site to complete private study when they do not have a scheduled examination.

Attendance at the exam feedback day and throughout the Headstart program is compulsory in preparation for the 2024 school year. Students are being encouraged to organise their Year 10 Work Experience prior to the end of the school year; they have been working on this in Pastoral but will need to continue this work at home.

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Examination details and requirements

Please note the following conditions related to examinations:

- Students are to wear College uniform; no PE lessons will run during this period, so there is no need for students to be wearing their PE uniforms.
- Students must bring their Student ID card to all examinations and place this on their desks.
- Students must bring their pencils, pens, highlighters etc in a clear pencil case/plastic bag.
- Calculators are not permitted in any exams other than Mathematics where instructed.
- Laptops/other devices are not required during examinations, with the exception of the PAT test on Monday, 20 November.
- Students are not permitted to bring mobile phones/Smart watches etc into the examination room. Any devices found on students will result in disciplinary action being taken.
