As the Year 9 Health teachers at Penola Catholic College, we are contacting you to provide a brief overview of our upcoming Health topics in Semester 2.

The Victorian Curriculum in Year 9 requires students to explore preventive health practices that build and optimise community health and wellbeing. In term 3, students will learn about Drug Education and Mental Health, followed by Relationships and Sexuality. In the Relationships and Sexuality topic the class will be unpacking respectful relationships and what this means and key concepts including respect, trust, and communication.

In addressing these topics, the College will consistently balance providing students with the important information and invaluable learning opportunities informed by the Victorian Curriculum, with respect for the teachings of the Catholic Church on relationships and sexuality.

The content of the unit will include:

- sexual consent, desire, and the topic of harassment
- communication skills
- safe sex practices,
- sexually transmitted diseases
- pregnancy, and contraceptive methods
- diverse genders and sexualities.

We would encourage all families, if they feel comfortable, to discuss these topics with their children to promote openness and respect as they learn about and investigate relationship skills, safe health practices, and respect for diversity in our community.
